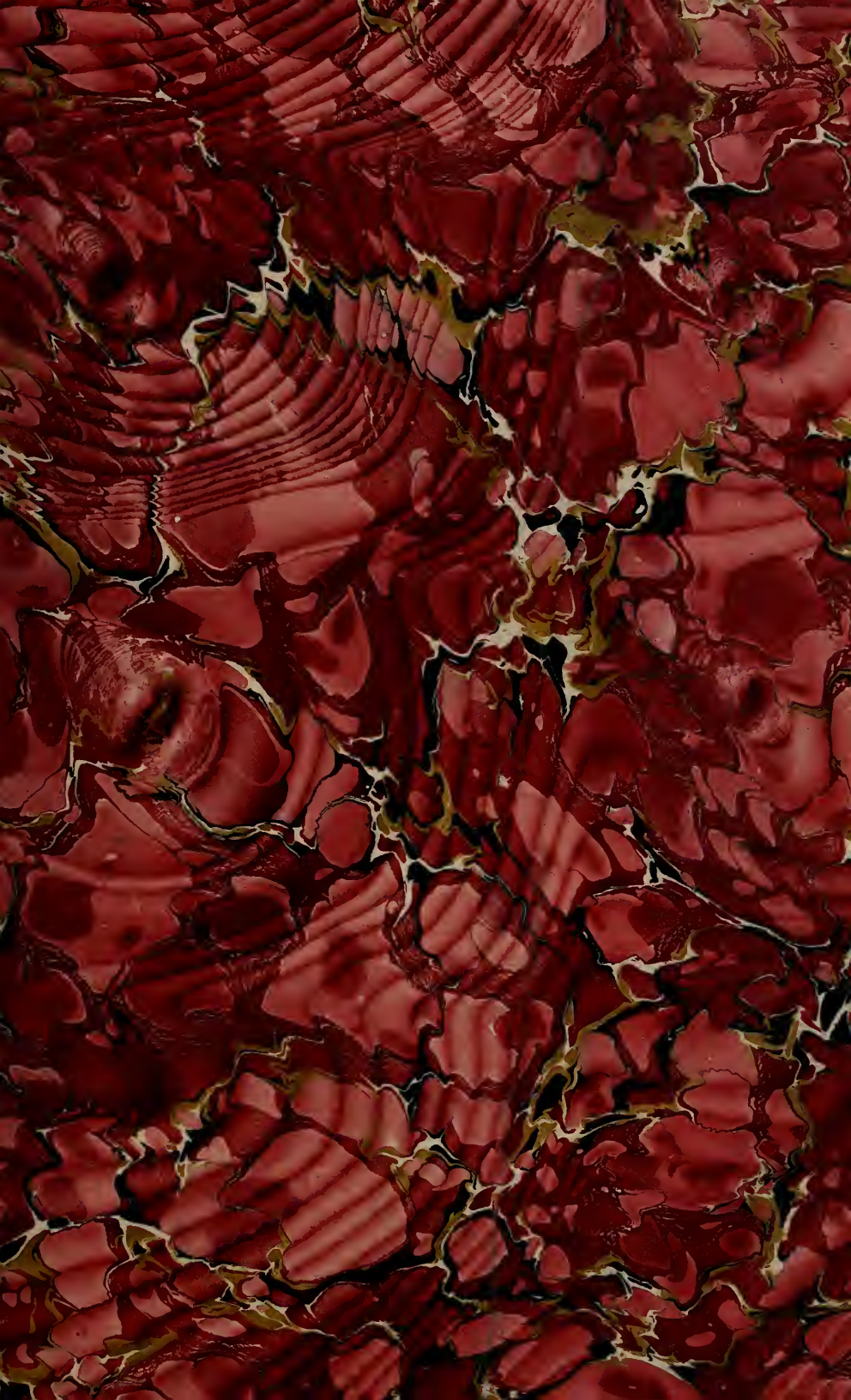

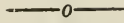

CONDITIONS OF SALE.

- II. No person to advance less than 1s.; above Five Pounds, 5s.; and so on in proportion.
- III. In the case of Lots upon which there is a reserve, the Auctioneer shall have the right to bid on behalf of the Seller.

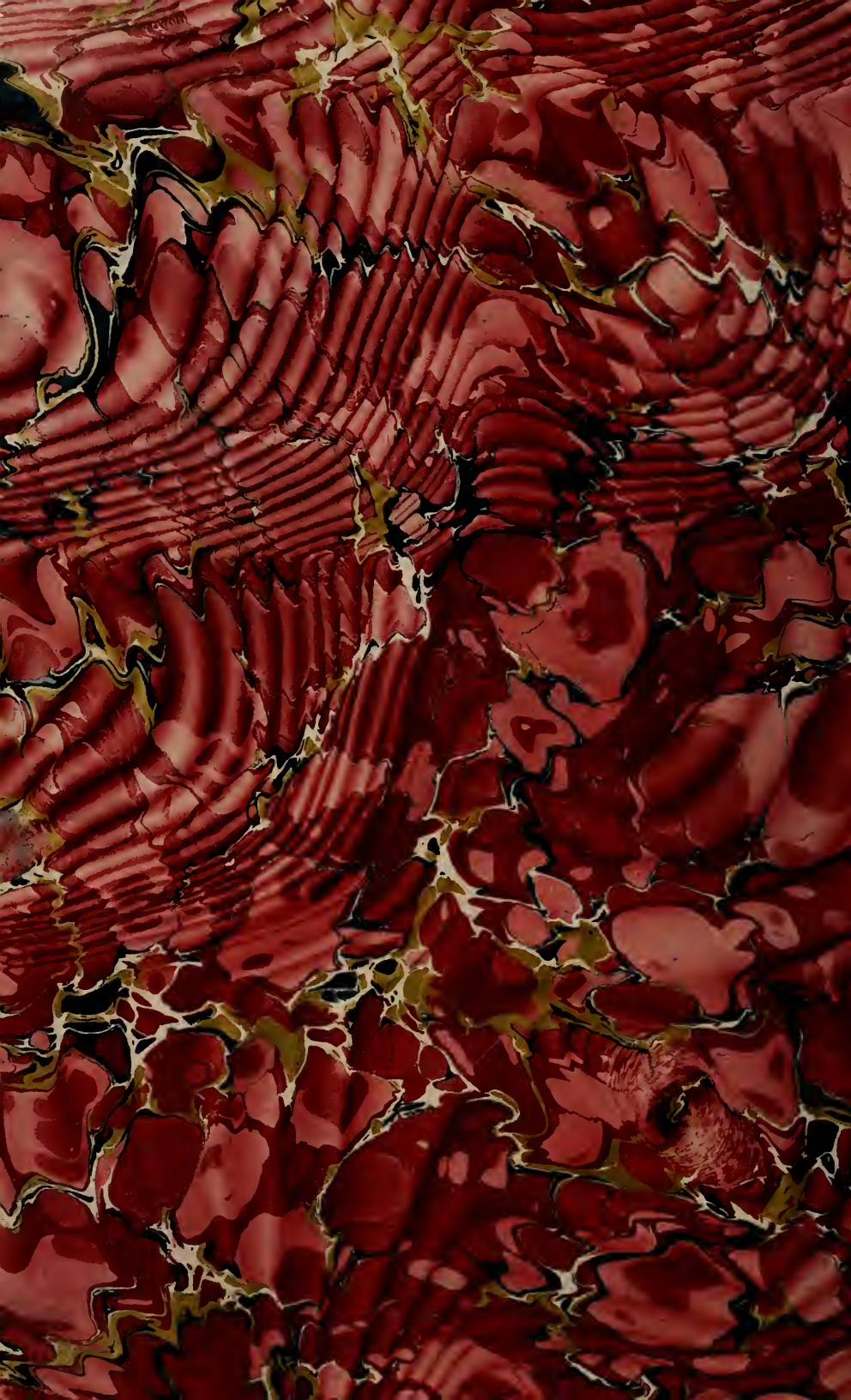
