Paris, Dec. 18.-The French war office this afternoon gave ou an official communication as follows; "The day of December 17 was marked, as we said yesterday, by an advance on our part in

In the region of Arras a vigorous offensive movement made us masters of several trenches. These trenches are located at Auchy La Bassee, St. Laurent and Blangy.- At this last mentioned place w occupied a front-more than one kilometre tong, almost all the first line trenches of the enemy.
