Not many first books win the wide and enthusiastic criticism that marked the publication of "Candles That Burn." The lyrics in this volume bore a rare beauty of thought and expression. Not less touched with loveliness is this new volume of verse by Aline Kilmer. Here are some thirty-odd poems which by a hidden magic transfix those moments of human experience and emotion that find us dumb. Mrs. Kilmer's lines have an unaffected beauty that is very moving.
