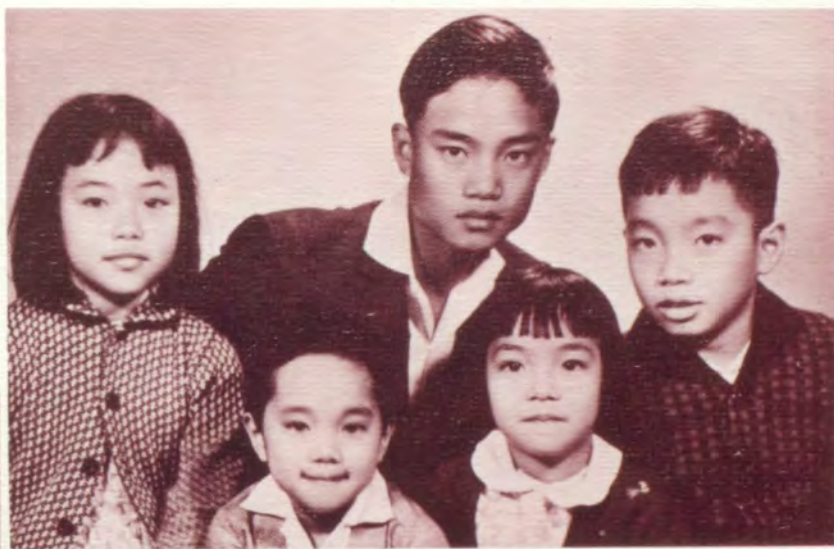

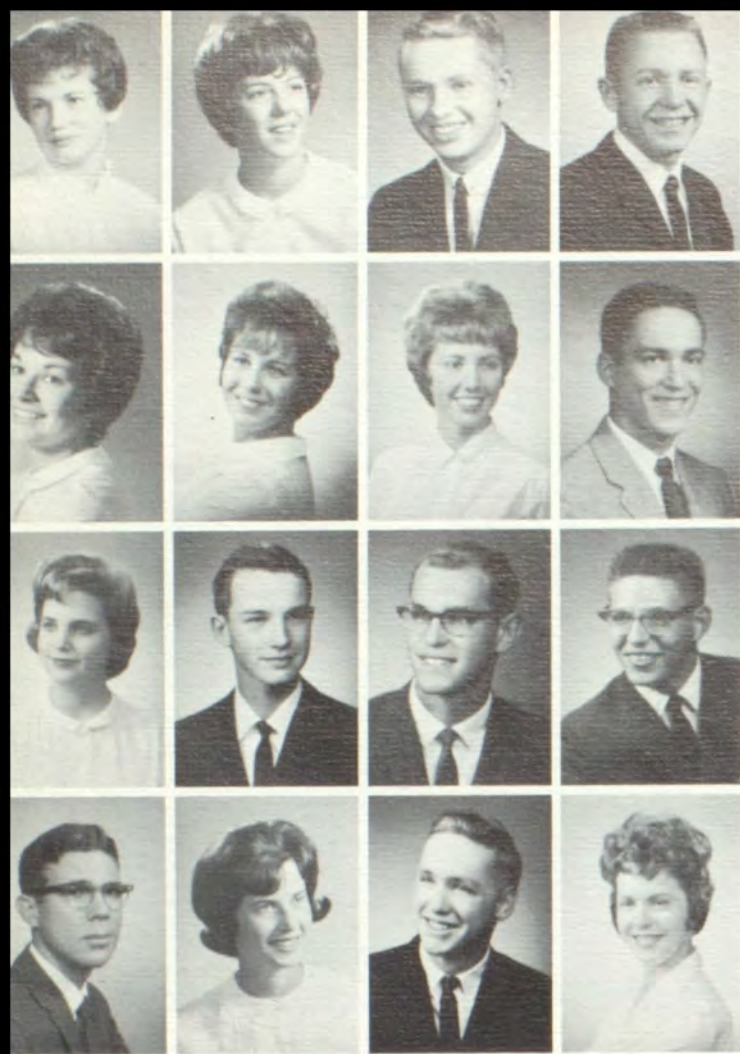


FFA HOLDS ANNUAL DANCE.
