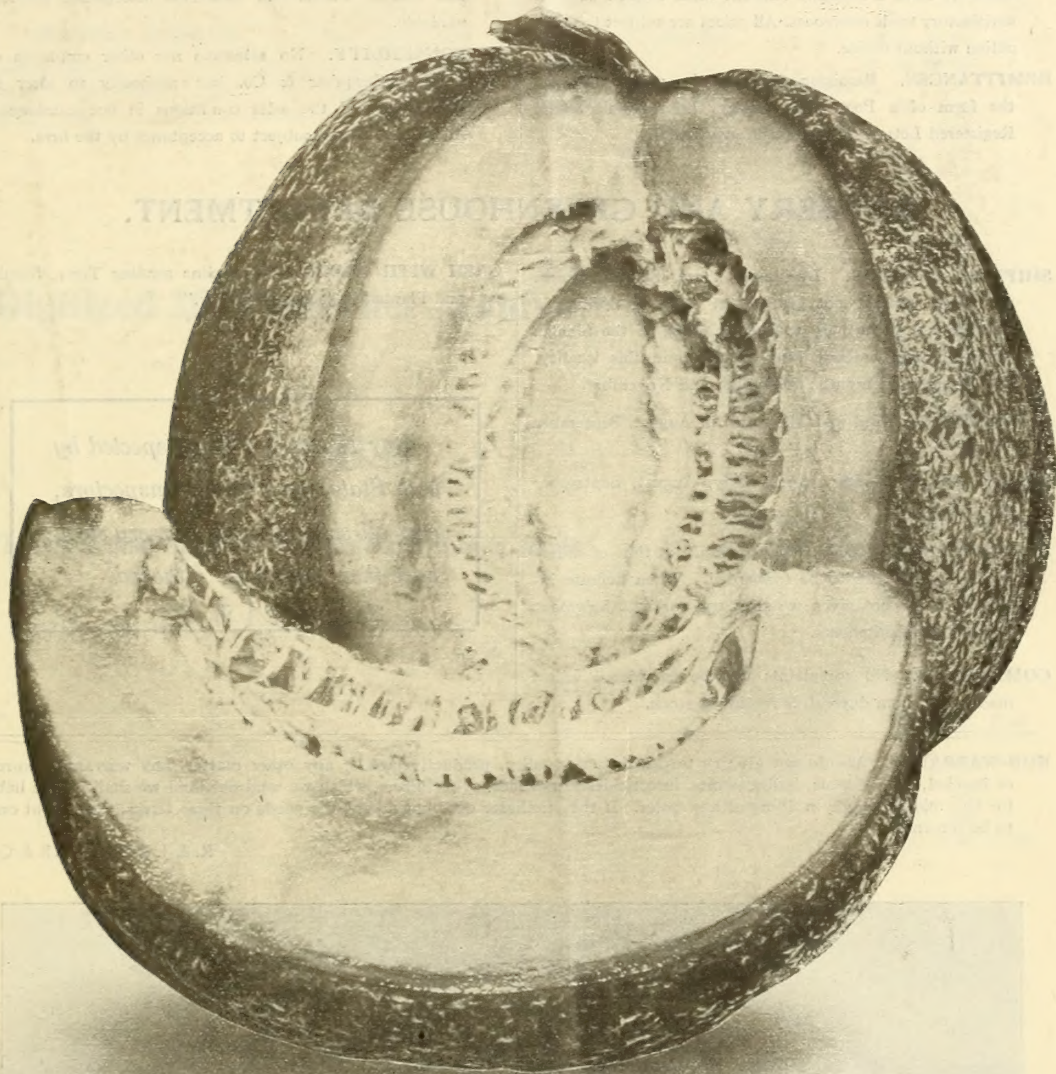

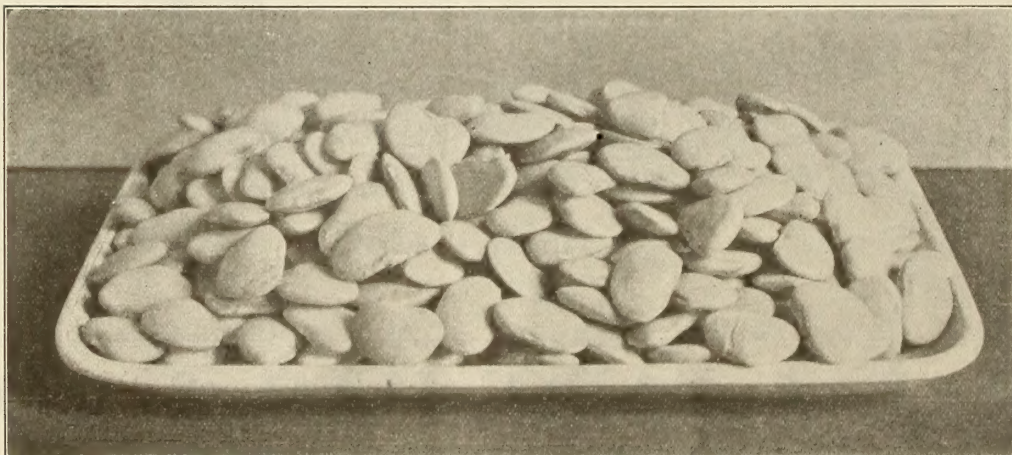
COMPLAINTS. No complaints will be considered unless made within ten days after receipt of stock.

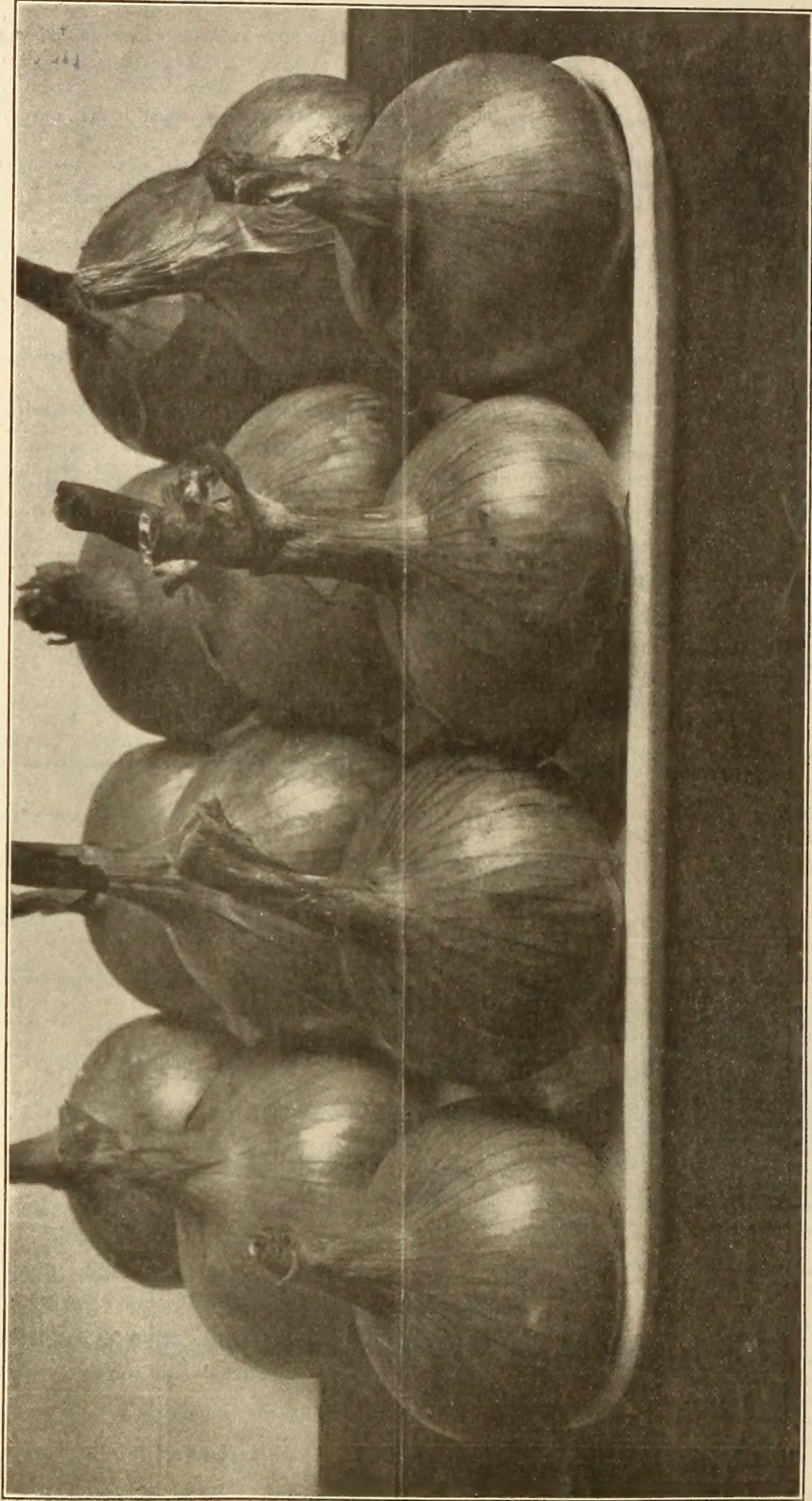
