TO OUR CUSTOMERS.

We take pleasure in calling your special attention to the prices herein given and the quality of the same—particularly to our large assortment and fine selection of Ornamental Shrubs and Climbing Vines—believing that many articles herein offered are worth double prices asked, and invite all to examine our stock—and low prices—for the quality, before purchasing.

THE PACKING SEASON usually commences in the Fall about the first week in October, and in the Spring about the first week in April.

ORDERS should state particularly the *form* and *height* of the trees desired—whether *standard* or *dwarf*,—the *varieties* and *quantities* of each—all of which should be *written plainly on a separate list (and not mixed up in the body of the letter)*.

If any errors have occurred in filling the orders, purchasers should *notify us immediately* so that we may at once make proper amends.

SHIPPING DIRECTIONS.—Plain and particular instructions should be given for *marking and shipping directions*. Where none are given, we will use our best judgment in forwarding them, and it **MUST BE UNDERSTOOD THAT ALL PACKAGES ARE AT THE PURCHASER'S RISK** after the delivery to the forwarders here; and all claims for damages should be made upon them.

PACKING CHARGES.—In packing, the cost of boxes or bales only will be charged, except to Agents and Dealers, to which will be added the cost of labor in assorting and filling orders; but all packages will be delivered at the Depot in Rochester, *free of charge*.

CONDITIONS OF SALE.—We reserve the right of selecting the varieties, which will consist of the leading and most desirable sorts, but in no case will we supply *long lists of selected varieties* of either Fruit or Ornamental Trees at wholesale rate, except as follows: *6 at the dozen rates, 50 at the 100 rates*. This rule will be strictly enforced. Owing to the very low prices, it costs more to deliver in small quantity than the price of the article. But we will make a *discount* from the retail prices, as such orders will justify.

Other articles that are not noticed in this list, will be found in our Descriptive Fruit, Ornamental and Greenhouse Catalogue, from which a *discount of one-third will be given*.

Terms.—CASH, unless otherwise *specially* agreed. *All bills must be settled within two months from the date of shipment or delivery.* All orders to be sent by Express, C. O. D., must be accompanied by one-half the amount in cash.

All articles after leaving our hands in good condition, are entirely at the risk of the purchaser; and no complaints for deductions for any cause whatever will receive consideration unless made promptly within ten days after the receipt of the goods.

At the prices named below, the assortment to be our selection of varieties. We will supply 6 at dozen rates, 50 at 100 rates. We will not fill orders for small quantities at the 100 rates. But we will give the purchaser the choice as far as consistent with the sorts we have.
