The class of 2002 is the last class to graduate under the auspices of The College's founding governance model. Terry Davies, The College's founder, steps down this year as President of The College and passes the torch to others to continue the work he started here in the Calgary community in 1982. A new, expanded Board of Directors has taken up the challenge of guiding the school's destiny and that is at once both exciting and invigorating. As the C.E.O./Headmaster in this new model, I look forward with keen anticipation to working with Chairman, Michael Tims, Past Chairman, Tony Pullman and the rest of The Board to ensure that Terry's legacy continues to flourish and that the next twenty years are as noteworthy as the first. 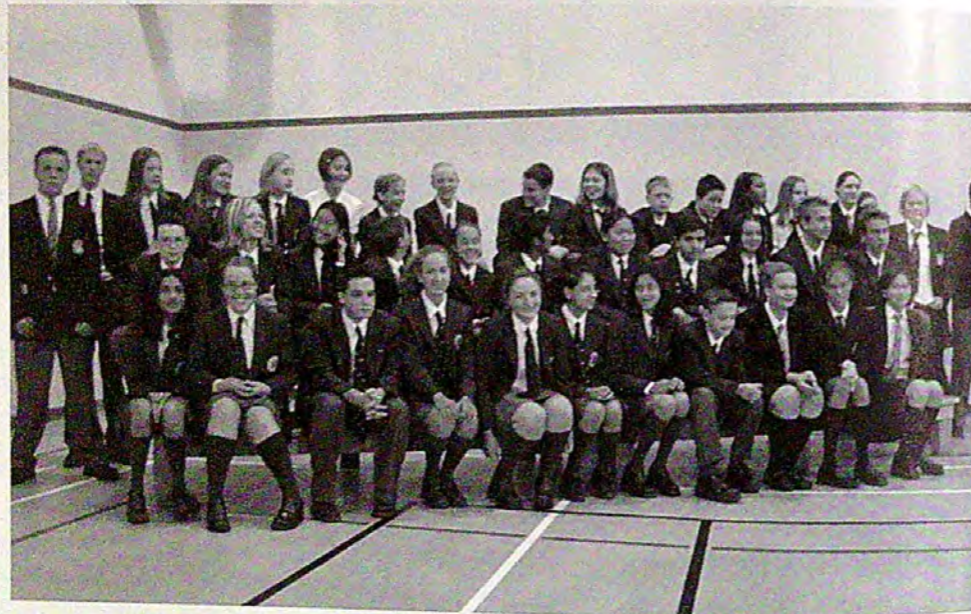
Soul Food Review by Sara Ross
