Anointing of the Sick



- Who's it for, what's it about?
 - Any one who is ill or undergoing life threatening surgery- NOT JUST THE DYING
- Where does the rite come from?
 - Jesus' healing example in the Bible
- What happens?
 - Priests lays hands on sick
 - Anoints person with oil that has been blessed
- What's the point?
 - Face death with courage, union with Christ – meet God in hope not fear

“Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up.”



The Funeral Rite



- What's the point?
 - To provide comfort to those who grieve
 - Lead them into a state of acceptance
- Process
 1. CALL TO PRAYER
 2. PLACING OF SYMBOLS
 - Pall, Cross, Missal, Rosary Beads
 3. WORDS OF REMEMBRANCE
 4. FINAL COMMENDATION
 - Signs of Farewell, Prayer of Commendation
