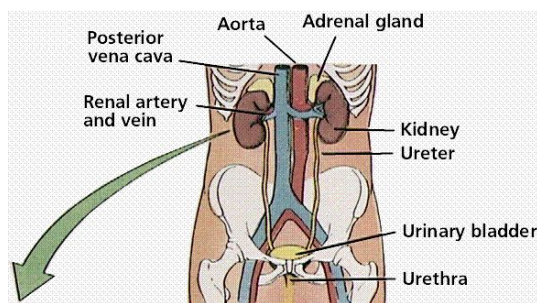


Excretory System

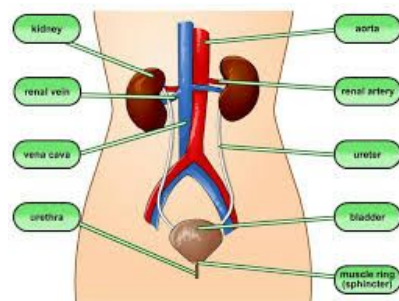
What is it?

How Does It Work?

Diseases

There are several diseases related to the excretory system, more problems can arise by a malfunctioning set of kidneys. Blood pressure is directly related to the level of fluid in your body. If a kidney does not work and does not filter correctly, blood pressure can rise to dangerous levels.
