	Amazon Kindle	Apple iPad
Display	E-ink display. Kindle 2 is 6 inches diagonally; Kindle DX is 9.7 inches diagonally. Not a touch screen.	9.7-inch LED (IPS) backlit display. Supports multi-touch.
Hardware	Kindle 2 is 10.2 ounces, Kindle DX is 18.9 ounces. Both are 0.36 inch thick, have navigation buttons, a toggle, 3.5mm headset jack, and a keyboard.	1.5 pounds, 0.5 inch thick, has a Home button, volume controls, a screen lock slide switch, and a 3.5mm headset jack.
Store	Amazon Kindle Store. Books are in Amazon's Kindle format.	iBooks store. Books are in the open ePub format.
Features	Able to subscribe to magazines and newspapers. Rudimentary Web browser, PDF reader, and 3G.	More than just an ebook reader. Has access to iTunes App Store, Safari browser, email, media player, games, and more. Has Bluetooth and WiFi. 3G in some models.

Price	Kindle 2 is \$259; Kindle DX is \$489. 3G is included.	iPads with WiFi only are \$499 for 16GB, \$599 for 32GB, and \$699 for 64GB. iPads with WiFi and 3G are \$629 for 16GB, \$729 for 32GB, and \$829 for 64GB. 3G data costs \$15 a month for 250MB and \$30 a month for unlimited.
