- Open Acrobat Elements and import the Sound booth file. Insert the images above the sound track. Save the Elements segment with your last name and drop it in my drop box so. I can share it with the engineer or you can transfer the segments using a flash drive.
- The podcast engineer may go to my share folder, drag the individual podcasts to the computer and insert them in the recording tracks.
