iGEM organization and the iGEM Giant Jamboree

The iGEM competition is an annually organized competition for undergraduate students in Synthetic Biology. The competition is organized by iGEM Headquarters in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA (<http://igem.org>). This year 245 student teams from around the world will present their work performed during the summer in their University. All iGEM competitors are invited to attend the Giant Jamboree. Composition and selection of participating teams

The attendee is responsible for the payment of the conference reservation fees, travel, and accommodations for his or her participation in the Jamboree. iGEM participants do not receive any salary or other compensation from iGEM Headquarters or the Jamboree organizers.

The organizing committee of the Giant Jamboree will do all that it can, and if necessary assist the attendee, to guarantee that he or she returns in time to the country of origin.
