

**EME: The Great Vowel Shift.** Given are the pronunciations (in IPA) of some ME words. Apply the principles of the Great Vowel Shift, and show the EME pronunciations of these words (in IPA). Finally, provide the PDE spelling of the words. Notice how the PDE spelling reflects the ME pronunciation, not the EME one, because the spelling system had been stabilized before the end of the Great Vowel Shift. Ignore the unstressed /ə/ on the ends of some words. (30 points)
