






Taniwha		If you are Taniwha: Taniwha Scores points by hitting and shooting the Ki to the rubbish bin. These points are called tupuwairua. If taniwha scores the play carry's on. Taniwha can take jump shots as long as the the Ki before landing.	The stick figure is shooting the Ki to the bin.
