Kioma	Circles with different zones with post around the zones .sort of like cricket. You stand around the circle	If you are Kioma: Kioma throw or kick the ball to a team mate who touches a post then can get more points by run it through the zone then place the ball on or over the Pawero line to score all post touches into points on the board. Kioma can not go through or over te ara to score.	
Taniwha	 Taniwha stand around the green zone with two in the white zone	If you are Taniwha: Taniwha scores by hitting the tupu with the ki and play carries on. Jump shots may be allowed if the taniwha player jumps from te roto and releases the ki before landing in Pawero, they must leave immediattely and not affect play or Kioma gain possession.
