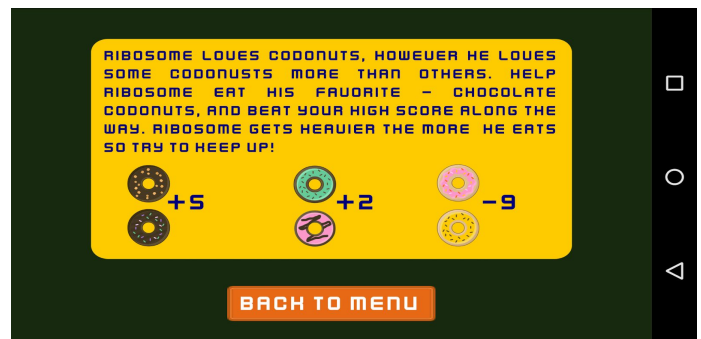

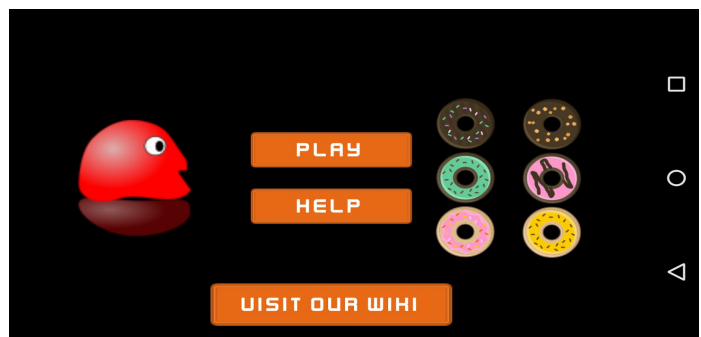
- **Lack of a proper explanation page**

The game starts without an explanation or story page. Because this app is an educational game, what it should start with is a proper explanation of what DNA, ribosomes, codons and maybe transcription and translation is. The explanation provided on the help page does not cover much, and for someone who is not aware of what codons and ribosomes are, does not really explain much.



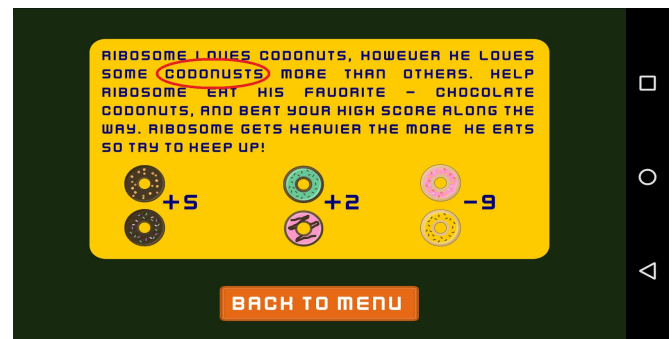
- **Lack of an instruction page**

The help page does not offer an explanation of how you are supposed to play the game itself. To elaborate, it does not contain anything saying you have to tap on the screen to keep the ribosome floating. Nor does it mention that you need to avoid the floors and ceiling



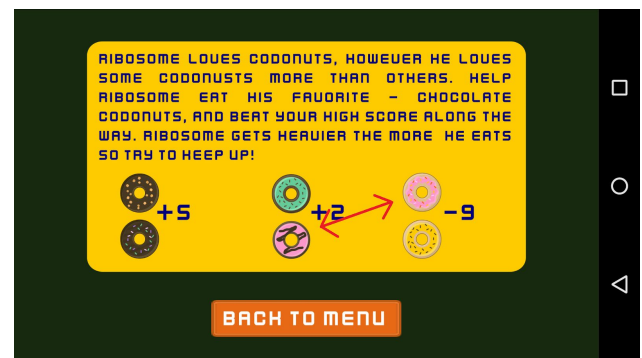
- **A (very tiny) spelling mistake.**

- **Codonut colors very similar**

The pink codonuts look too similar when playing the game. One gets confused about which ones to avoid and which ones to grab! Maybe a different color or size could help?



- **Reactions**

The lack of reactions kind of takes the fun out of the game. There is no vibration, or sound when the wrong codonut is eaten by ribosome. The score gets deducted without any indication. Would be really better to have some sort of response.
