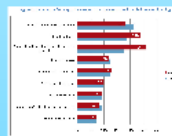
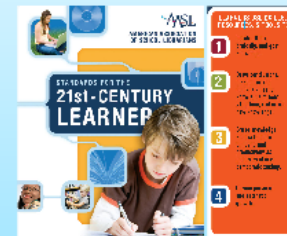

are used to receiving information...REALLY fast.

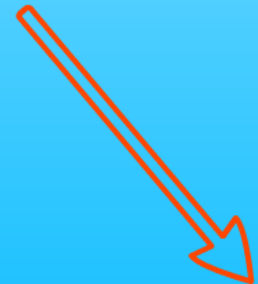
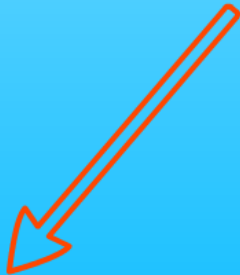
