

Idea 1

1) A simple identifier: (a few words)

"My project will be a Library."

2) A short description: (a few sentences)

"My project will be about mental and physical healthcare center, a library which combines recreation and physical wellness."

3) A pointed case statement: (a paragraph or two)

"My project will be developed because as in a lot of other countries, Georgian youngster slowly moves away from books and literature and I believe the solution could be in rethinking the traditional design of libraries.

The topic of my Bachelor's degree final thesis was an extension of Lithuanian foreign ministry, with a lot of public and private spaces, where I started thinking about balanced development of individuals by providing them both physical and mental activities under one roof. This time I would like to go deeper into the topic and relate it to my country, where I see destructive results of collapsed education system."

Idea 2

"My project will be an Elderly Recreation and Daycare Center."

2) A short description: (a few sentences)

"My project will be about an institution concentrated on assistance and recreation of elderly people who retire from their daily routines and go through existential crisis, have troubles finding new entertainments or need physical assistance."

"My project will be developed because globalization brought a need of redefinition of lifestyle in families in my country. Traditionally, Georgian families included people of at least three generations living together. Older ones would take care of their youngster, until the youth was ready to take over; therefore, every younger person was responsible for his parents and grandparents. In the last 20 years western routine turned the traditions upside-down and young people started developing independently; everyone works hard and they have no time big families anymore. However, it is still unacceptable for the society to send parents in retirement housing. Psychologists started looking for a solution and researching the concept of daycare centers.

I would like to find an architectural language for people as delicate and sensitive, as elderly. In a center I would unify the needs of health and entertainment and I would also like to introduce the Scandinavian concept of after-retirement education centers to help people through existential crisis."

Idea 3

"My project will be a reconstruction of an urban area of Tbilisi Old Town."

"My project will be about a reconstruction of a very crucial urban node of my hometown. Since the last century the area went through dramatic changes and is reaching its peak currently, as the government is building a project of monstrous scale, covering the entire old town of the city. I would like to challenge myself in solving this extremely complex urban problem."

3) A pointed case statement: (a paragraph or two)

"My project will be developed because the recent developments in the old town of Tbilisi have been disturbing me; the nod connecting the oldest part the city to newer developments has always been thought as a separate land, rather than looking at it as a connecting piece of the puzzle. The area of a great value for local people is going through "Singaporization" and I am interested to look deep into the problem. I am curious why decisions were made in certain ways, if there could be a better solution for urban reconstruction and if yes, how I would solve it."
