

RESEARCH SHOWS THAT GENERIC ASPECTS OF TEACHING MUST BE IN PLACE IN ORDER TO HAVE AN EFFECTIVE LESSON (LYONS AND PINNELL 2001)

1. Materials – Are the basic materials needed accessible?
2. Organization – Is the teacher prepared?
3. Time- Does the teacher have sufficient time for each part of the lesson?
4. Pace – Does the lesson move along?
5. Intensity – is the teacher actively teaching in an energetic and persistent way throughout the lesson?
6. Feedback – When the teacher responds to a student, is the response constructive, specific, and grounded in students' behavior?
7. Interaction – Does the teacher interact with all the students?
8. Engagement – Are all the students engaged in the lesson? Does the teacher hold the attention of each student?
9. Enthusiasm – Does the teacher show enthusiasm?
10. Rapport – Does the teacher connect with the children in meaningful ways?
