



## Cash for Class



Classroom dollars will be awarded to those students who demonstrate exceptional classroom or academic behavior. These dollars are YOUR responsibility, so if any are lost or stolen, they will not be replaced. Throughout each quarter, students will have the opportunity to purchase a few small school supply items (rep pens, pencils, spirals, etc.)

### How do I get class dollars?

1. Have your planner signed by your parent or guardian.
2. Turn your assignments in on time.
3. Keep your supplies and desk area clean and organized.
4. Treat others respectfully.
5. Take responsibility for your own actions.

### Can my money be taken away?

Yes! Fees and fines will be assessed for student who are not behaving/acting in the expected manner. Some examples are:

Disrespect to adults or other students, breaking classroom rules, not following building rules or specials teachers' rules, missing assignments, receiving a refocus, not working silently, not beginning work when expected, as well as others that have been covered in class.

### What if I am in the negative, but don't have any money?

It is possible to go into the negative, and if this should happen, you will have to give an IOU. As soon as any money is awarded to you for good behavior, you will need to apply that money directly to your IOUs by paying the teacher or classmate you owe. If at the end of the quarter, you still are in the negative and still have IOUs, you will have to perform community service in the classroom with a helpful task.

### Bonuses

Students who go beyond the minimum expectations may receive bonus dollars. These may be given for things like: 100%s, extreme courtesy to adults or other students, outstanding citizenship, etc.

Please note that classroom dollars cannot be given away to friends, borrowed, or traded to anyone. If it is discovered that this is happening, both students will lose all their dollars, and they will not be able to participate.
