

# Global Natives Project

**Objective:** To be able to communicate knowledge of a Global Native tribe through visual and oral communication

**Product:** Wiki page, Museum Artifact and presentation at Open House

In this multi-stage project you will work with 5 others to create a museum display that will show your understanding and knowledge of the Global Tribe that you have researched. You must work **hard, efficiently and collaboratively** to finish your museum display so that on the Global Native Open House you may present your project to the world.

The project will be divided into four areas. Each group member will need to be involved in all four areas. These areas include:

## RESEARCH PLANNING THE DISPLAY MAKING THE ARTIFACTS and WRITING THE SPEECH PRESENTATION

You will be on a tight timeline and will have to meet deadlines throughout the project. The likely timeline will be.

- 2 Preparation lessons
- 3 Planning and learning about the research process
- 3 Researching work periods
- 8 Planning of the Building and writing of the speech work periods
- 2 Practice periods
- 2 Presentation periods at the open House

Your group needs to identify and research a Global Native Tribe. After researching the three areas you must then decide on a display that demonstrates your knowledge and understanding of the culture of your tribe. Each Global Native group will be responsible for 3 of these cultural areas. Please select your cultural areas from the following list.

Food and Cooking  
Customs, Celebrations and Ceremonies  
Technology and Adaptations to Environments  
History, Famous People and Important Events  
Tribal Living, Clothing and Shelter  
Religion and Beliefs

When researching you must record your information on a wiki in the form of a Annotated Bibliography.

Once you have your areas researched then you group of 6 must convene a meeting to plan what artifacts you will make. At this meeting you will write a contract that states who is doing what for the building and speech writing section of this project.

You will then go about making the artifact and writing a 1 minute speech that you will use when people come to your museum display.

Lastly come the day of the Open House you will be responsible to inform the visitors about your Native people and their culture. You should be able to answer questions and communicate what you have learned.
