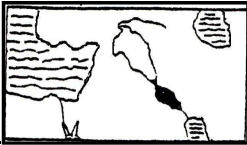
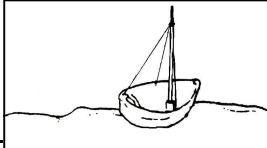


## 1. Geography

## 3. Religion and Philosophy



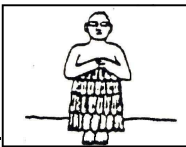
- Worshiped 300 deities

- Girls didn't go school
- Only sons of wealthy families went to school    ran by priests
- Located at ziggurat

## 5. Political Science



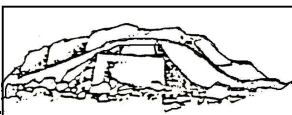
- Priests were first leaders
- Military leaders were chosen as rulers when conflict increased
- When a ruler dies they would be replaced by a relative

## 6. Sociology



- Each society is made up of upper middle lower and slave classes
- Men were head of household
- Women had some rights

## 7. History



- Settlements grew into city-states
- City states were surrounded by dependent rural area , villages and towns
