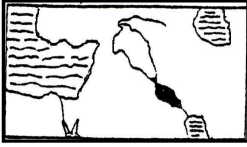


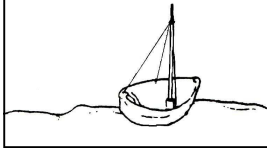
Questions to Ask About a Culture

3. Religion and Philosophy



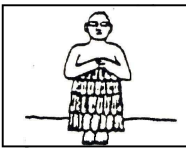
- 3000 gods

4. Knowledge, Education, and the Arts



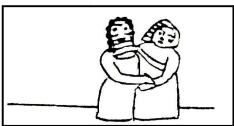
- Guys only went to school

5. Political Science



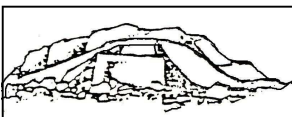
- Talking about politics, economics, and government
