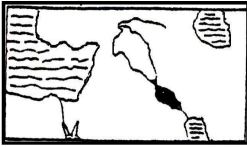


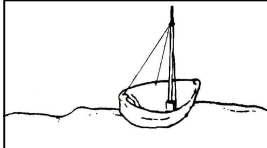
Questions to Ask About a Culture

3. Religion and Philosophy



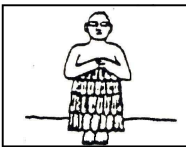
- worshiped 300 deities

5. Political Science



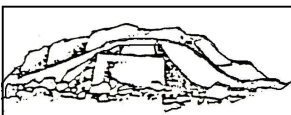
- city states
