Rhetorical Triangle

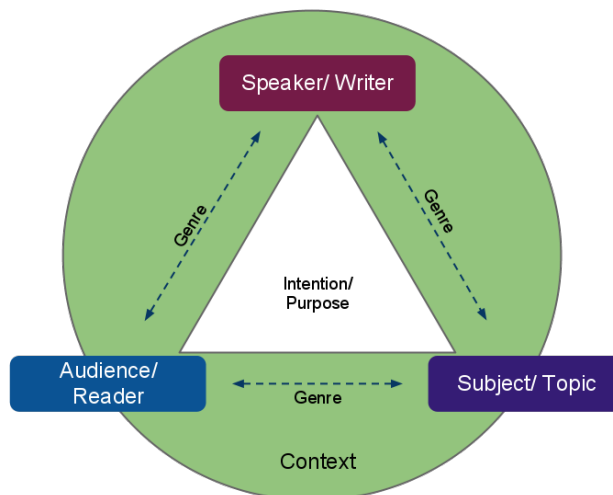

Explain a Big Idea

- How do the writer's techniques lead to that Big Idea
 - Explain the big idea (tone, purpose, point of view)
 - Find techniques (fig lang, diction, structure, etc)
 - Explain how techniques links backs to support big idea
