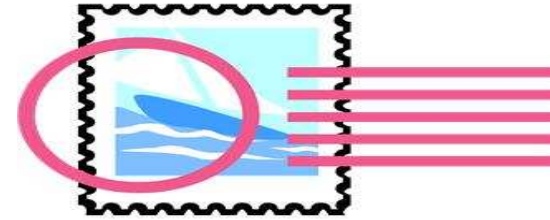


Dear Darren,
