

Hey Dad,

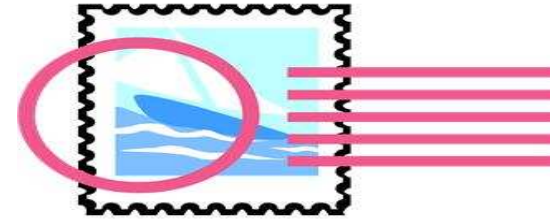
As you may know, I'm currently journeying the marvellous country of England. I just came back from Salisbury Plain to view Stonehenge.
