

Hi Janessa,

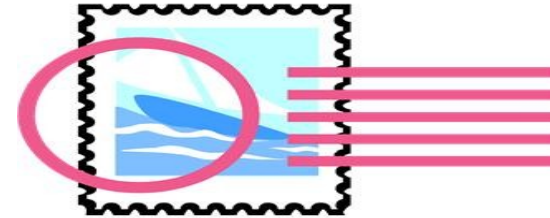
