In the day light came from the doorway

And in the night they used a fireplace in the middle of the roundhouse or they used rush lights



4. Who is the famous Celtic female [fighter](#)? What did she wear?

Bouddicia is the famous Celtic fighter and she wore colourful tunic, a gold torch around her neck and a cape of thick tweed pinned with a brooch.
