

# Calendars and Dates

Age Group: Young Adults/ Adults

Level: High Entry 1 and Entry 2

Time: 1 hour

Skill focus: Days, months, numbers and ordinals.

Sub skills: Obtaining meaning from tables.

Materials: Worksheet.

Curriculum References: Rw/E1.1a      Wt/E1.1a      Rw/E2.2a      Wt/E2.1a

1. Give the students a quick test. On a bit of paper have them write the numbers 1-20 leaving spaces for answers. Call out the following words and have students write down the answers.

2. Explain that there are two ways of writing the date. The long way, (Fifteenth of June 2004) and the short way (15/06/04). Explain that when spoken, the numbers in dates need 'th' on the end of them. Don't expect students to pick this up straight away. It will need a bit of practise.

3. Give students the worksheet and complete Part 1- Ordinals. Go through the answers.
