WHAT/DESCRIPTION

ACTION NAME: Activities related to the Red Cross at RKNUWC

WHAT/DESCRIPTION

1. Follow up the Outline Agreement through the established Contact Group, which involves both the Norwegian RC and Sogn & Fjordane RC.
2. Define clearly the role of the Red Cross coordinator at the college to prevent duplication of work and conflicts planning.
3. Ensuring that the Red Cross Diploma has a central place in the Extra Academic Program, as a means of ensuring that our students gain knowledge and skills related to the Red Cross and that they receive a formal recognition of this.
4. Carry out recruitment of land mine victims as students together with the Norwegian Red Cross and Haugland Rehabilitation.
5. Continue to develop links with local hjelpekorps.

MEASURABLE GOALS

1. Develop Red Cross Youth and a Red Cross umbrella group on campus to provide support for activities related to the Red Cross principles.
Offer local schools first aid training, perhaps utilizing the "Young First Aider" program from St. John Ambulance.
Offer the "Raw War" game to local schools.
2. Prepare and agree a job description. Appoint a staff member internally
3. Further develop the plan for running "På Flukt" together with the Norwegian Red Cross and the County office in Førde, possibly using the house and facilities at Heggness into use.
4. Establish selection teams. Selection of candidates for college scholarships. Raise funding for rehab costs.
5. Develop a preliminary training course at the college for students who then attend the Hjelpekorps Grunnkurs at Nesholmen.

TIMEFRAME AND MILESTONES

1,2,3 immediate completed prior to Jan 1st 2011

4 Places reserved at RCNUWC Sept 2010. Teams established Jan 2011. Selection by April 2011. Enter college August 2011.

RESPONSIBLE PERSONS

Led by Director of Development with support from Red Cross Coordinator and CAS Coordinator

COST/RESOURCES

Scholarships within normal RCN budget no extra costs
Rehab costs from fundraising or grants
Additional staff training first aid teaching (PD budget)

ACTION NAME: *Extending RCNUWC short course in China to Australia, Ghana and India.*

WHAT/DESCRIPTION

Explore the possibility of running RCNUWC short course in Australia, Ghana and India.

Content for the short courses can be changed as per local requirements

MEASURABLE GOALS

- (i) *Identifying partners in Australia, Ghana and India by Rupert, Daniel and Ashok respectively. The partner institution should in general share the same ideals as us.*
- (ii) *Work out the feasibility of running a short course in these countries on the lines of the one that Xiaohang concluded successfully in partnership with Ningxia University, in June/July, 2010.*

TIMEFRAME AND MILESTONES

- (i) *It was felt that winters in India will be more suitable for running this programme as compared to summer. However, this creates a different set of difficulties.*
- (ii) *No target date has been identified. It was understood that a time frame of at least a year or even more may be required to get the projects started.*
- (iii) *Xiaohang will be repeating her successful short course in China in 2011 or 2012.*
