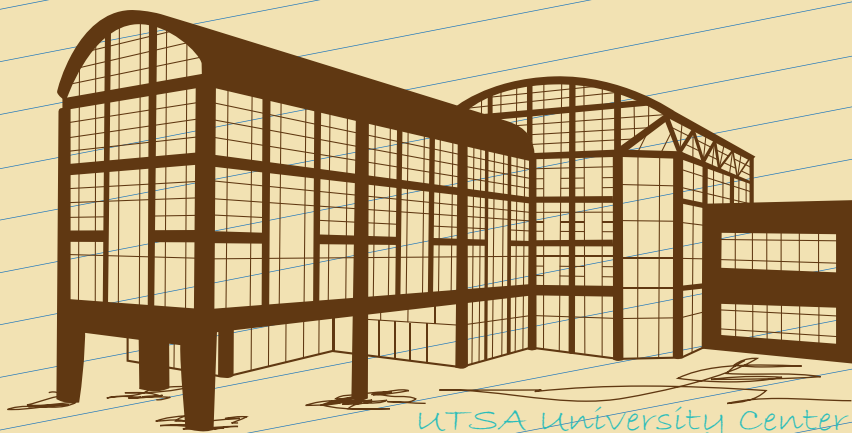

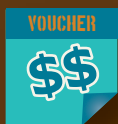

HOST SITE: UT SAN ANTONIO

Founded by the Texas Legislature in 1969, UTSA now offers access and opportunity for nearly 29,000 students. UTSA has come a long way in a short time, from meeting in an office park in 1973 to three campuses in 2010: The Main Campus on San Antonio's northwest side, the Downtown campus on Frio and Durango streets and the HemisFair Park campus, which is home to the Institute of Texan Cultures. Students can now choose from 133 graduate and undergraduate degree programs and will experience the school's first football game in the fall of 2011. UTSA is the second largest component of the University of Texas System and has been one of the state's fastest-growing public universities for much of the last decade.
