## ANIMOTO

1. Here is a link to my sample animoto video so you can see a simple project: <http://animoto.com/play/FswilB3v4rNTBjulqEZnDA>
2. Go to your H drive (assuming you are doing this at school). Create a new folder. Name it "images"
3. Go to [www.pics4learning.com](http://www.pics4learning.com). Search for any topic of interest or use the topic browse feature. Save 7-10 images in your new images folder.
4. Go to [www.animoto.com](http://www.animoto.com)
5. Sign up for a free subscription (there is an educator's free subscription too, but we'll start with the basics)
6. Click on "create video" in the blue box at the top right.
7. Choose one of their free styles (always choose the free option)
8. Upload the images from your Images folder
9. Use the tool bar under the images to shift, sort, add text to make a story. Make sure you make a title slide with your name as the subtitle
10. Click done when you are satisfied with the lay out.
11. Go to <http://www.soundzabound.com/> **username** - silverhills **password** - adams12
12. Browse by category. Choose a selection to go with your slide show. Make sure it is at least 30 seconds long (the length of your slide show). Download your selection.
13. Go back to animoto and "upload from your computer." It may be in a music or download folder.
14. Save and continue. Don't make any changes on the 1st "customize your video" page, but give it a title and description. Click "create my video" and go have a cup of coffee (this step takes awhile). You will get an email when it is done.
15. Give me the link to your finished project.. Click on "video tool box" and "share" and "share link"
16. Where could you use this in your class? In your personal life?
17. On a scale of 1-10, how difficult does this rank? Why?



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
