CUT TO:

CUT TO:

CUT TO:

INT. THE PRESIDENT'S LIVING ROOM - DAY

He lifts the lid of another large box and leans forward to
looks inside.

CUT TO:

INT. ENROLLMENT SERVICES - DAY

Students stand in line at Zimbar-Liljenstein Hall.

As we move through the line of students, we see students sitting at front area cubicles. Staff members help, as administrative heads look on.

MR. WELSH (V.O.)

Yes Marsha, I must agree. What commitment!

CUT TO:

INT. THE PRESIDENT'S LIVING ROOM - DAY

Marsha stops in the mist of reaching for another box.

MARSHA

Wait a minute; I have an idea. Why don't I just send out a tweet. I'm sure someone's seen it.

Marsha pulls her phone from her pocket and begins to tweak a message.

CUT TO:

The screen of Marsha's phone appears as we read her tweet.

SUPER:

SUPER:

CUT TO:

DISSOLVE TO:

A large sign is held up within the back area of the group. It reads:

SIGN:

The Warrior Spirit!

As the group yells

The group then lets out a loud cheer.

CUT TO:

INT. SOMEWHERE - DAY

A box lid, showing only Burgy's hands, closes over an imaginary box. The top of the lid shows
