

Full PSUSD meeting covers charters, budget cuts and Desert Hot Springs High

The Palm Springs Unified School District board of education will discuss adult education, transportation and charter schools during its regular meeting on Tuesday.

The board will vote on a resolution to deny the Palm Springs Conservatory Charter School's petition based on concerns over its budget and other policies, according to board documents.

The board will also hear about the district's plans for home to school transportation and the scaled back adult education program during the meeting.

A public hearing will also be held to give the community an opportunity to give input on the changes being made at Desert Hot Springs High School, recently named one of the state's persistently lowest achieving schools.

The public meeting will be held at 6 p.m. in the district boardroom, 980 Tahquitz Canyon Way, Suite 101, in Palm Springs.

Desert Art Center will be given the board's Shiny Apple Award for its support of art education in the district.

Anna Orduno of Rio Vista Elementary will receive the classified employee of the month award for April and Norm McKee of Desert Springs Middle will receive the certificated employee of the month
