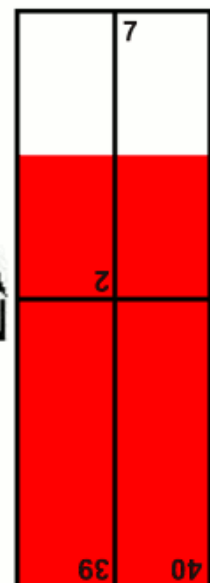


FOSSUM, NORWAY, 12 APRIL 1940: Lead elements of the central German column moving toward Askim were ambushed when they dismounted to clear a roadblock at the Glåma Bridge. They took positions on the mountainside overlooking the western shore and searched for options to cross the river.

Board Configuration:



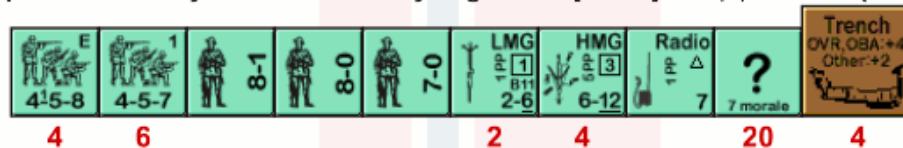
(Only hexrows R-GG on board 7 and A-P on board 2 are playable)



VICTORY CONDITIONS: The Germans win by solely occupying 40I8 or 40CC8 provided the Norwegians are unable to project ≥ 12 FP (not including ROF) on any hex of either bridge.

Norwegians setup first. Balance: Add one 8-0 to the Norwegian OB.

Improved Infantry units from Artillery Regiment 1 [ELR:3] set up per SSR3: {SAN: 3}

Germans moves first. Balance: Remove 5 "?" from Norwegian OB

Elements of the 2nd Battalion, 362nd Regiment [ELR: 3] set up on boards 39 and 2 in hexes numbered ≤ 7 : {SAN: 2}

SSR:

1. EC are Wet, with no wind at Start. Ground Snow (E3.72) is in effect [EXC: the river is frigid, not frozen]. Orchards are out of season.

2. Place overlays as follows: **RR1** on 2A6/A7, **RR2** on 7GG6/GG7 [EXC: the section of the Railroad overlay from GG4 – GG7 represents a wooden railroad bridge over the river, treat the open ground on those four overlay hexes as water obstacles]. The overlays represent a GIRR. There is a

two-lane stone bridge in hexes 40I2 and 40I3. The roads in 40I1 and 40I4 extend to the bridge.

3. The Norwegians must divide their forces into two groups each of which must contain at least 3 squads. One group sets up on boards 7 and/or 40 north of the 40AA5-Y10 road, the other sets up on board 40 south of the 40Q4-Q7-Q10 road.

4. The Norwegians receive one module of 70+mm OBA, the Germans receive one module of 80+mm Mortar OBA.

END

AFTERMATH: The day was spent in an almost continuous firefight while the Germans made probing attacks at the railroad bridge at Langenes and the dam at Kykkelsrud. Both probes were repulsed, but the Germans were finally able to take the Glåma Bridge in an attack later that night.
