Here are some ideas of things you can use when creating your own comic book. Experiment and have fun!

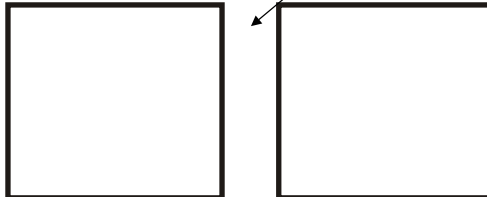
Frames -

Used to contain the comic panels.



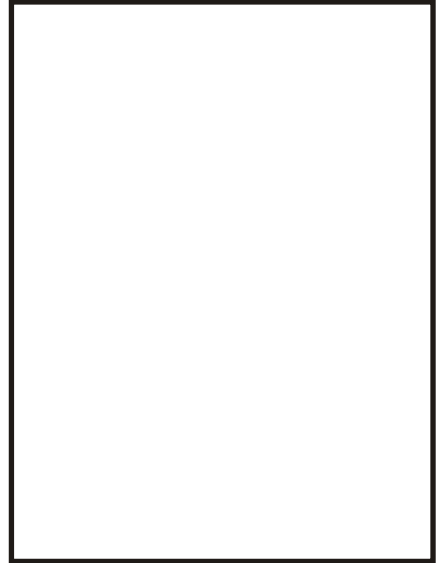
Gutter -

The space between the frames. Use this space to create extra backgrounds or to add color.



Splash Frame -

A frame that takes up the space of several frames. Used for larger scenes.



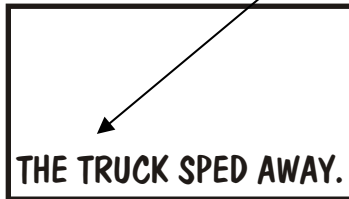
Narratory Block -

Used for narrators text.



Captions -

Used for text that speaks directly to the reader.



Emanata Text -

Pictures used to represent what is going on, in this example, it represents a "bright idea"



Labels -

Used to label objects or places



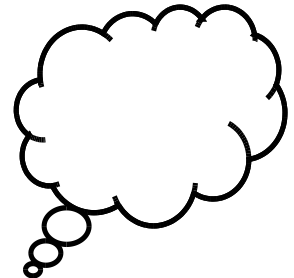
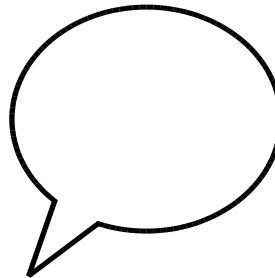
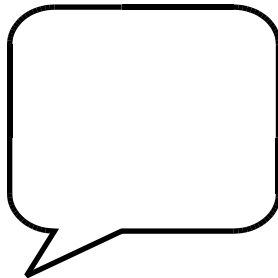
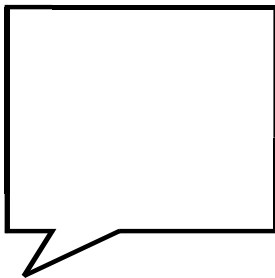
Action Block -
