

## Week 8: Subject-Verb Agreement

Day One:

Sometimes the subject of your sentence is **one** person or thing. Then, you should choose a verb which **agrees with**, or matches your **one-person** subject. This is called subject-verb agreement.

Ex: James is reading a magazine.  
one-part verb  
subject

Ex: The dog is hungry.  
one-part verb  
subject

You would NOT say, "James are reading a magazine." The verb **are** does not agree with or match the subject, (James) which is **one** person.

Notice that all subjects are **one** person or thing.
