Expectations/Expectaciones:

1. In groups of two you will create a poster about one of the key themes of the Día de los Muertos celebration.
2. You must find specific information related to the topic to create the poster.
3. The Poster
 - a. This must be your own work. Do not copy from a book, a web site, or other source. Do not cut and paste. Paraphrase and rewrite the information.
 - b. Use the poster paper provided.
 - c. Write neatly or type your own information.
 - d. Include pictures or drawings that best represent your topic making sure to identify the source of your pictures.
 - e. You must use information from three different articles.
 - f. Title your poster.
 - g. On the back of your poster write the internet sites that provided your information and your pictures.
4. You will be presenting your poster on **October 30**.
 - a. You will not have time to work on the poster in class on that date. They are due at the beginning of the period. (Do not ask for materials to finish your poster when you enter the room on that date.)
 - b. You must explain your theme. You will not be able to read from the poster or any other materials.

Themes/Temas:

1. José Guadalupe Posada
2. Skeletons/Esqueletos
3. Candies/Dulces
4. Foods/Comida (not candy) minimum of 5 & explain what they are and what they are made of
5. Altars/Ofrendas
6. Aztecs and Indian/Indigenous Groups
7. Spanish/los españoles
8. Graves/Tumbas, Cemeteries/Cementarios
9. Children/Niños (deceased) & Butterflies/Mariposas (not related)
10. Meaning of Día de los Muertos
11. Colors/Colores
12. Flowers/Flores

Grade/Calificación: 30 points

Neatness: Did you cut out pictures neatly, draw them well (10 pts)

Information: Did you cover the specific information adequately?

(10 pts = 10 pieces of information?)

On Time: Completed on time (5 pts)

Creative: Is it a plain, boring poster or does it catch attention? (5 pts)
