1	<p><b>Essen und Trinken - Overview</b></p> <p>* Pre-test first</p> <p>Ask if chn can think of any typical German foods they know about.</p> <p>Tell them about some famous ones:</p> <p>Sausages, beer, sauerkraut, Schwarzwälder Kirschtorte</p> <p>Meat (especially pork) &amp; potatoes form a large part of the diet, especially pork</p> <p>Brainstorm what we like to eat for Breakfast in Australia - typical meal.</p> <p>Fold 3 x workbook pages in half, label: Frühstück, Mittagessen, Abendbrot. On each page list &amp; draw some key objects that we would eat for these meals..</p> <p>Then discuss a typical German Breakfast</p> <p>New page, write phrases "Ich esse ..." 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2	<p><b>Frühstück</b>            Explain literal meaning for word in German.            List the types of foods chn drew in their workbooks for a normal breakfast. Discuss whether people skip breakfast sometimes &amp; whether this is healthy.</p> <p>Then read about a typical breakfast - Germany Live, p24</p> <p>Create a list on board/smartboard of food items for a typical German breakfast.            Discuss which items are similar/different to us            Discuss why chn think these might be popular food items in Germany. Discuss meaning of the word.            Read out some things chn wrote that they eat for lunch.            Read smartboard file / Germany Live book section on Mittagessen.            Create class list of typical German foods.            Discuss how &amp; why this is similar/different from our typical lunch. 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4	<p><b>Abendessen</b>  Read the smartboard file about this meal.  Compare and contrast to Australian dinner meal. Discuss why it might be different.  Which do children prefer?  Copy list &amp; illustrate in workbooks.</p> <p>Kaffee und Kuchen  Read Smartboard file about this meal. How is it the same/different to afternoon tea?</p> <p>Discuss famous German foods... Introduce the denominations used for Euro &amp; discuss which countries use them. Show the symbol. €            Chn play game where they travel round a board collecting Euro on each spot they land.            At corner spots they are able to purchase an item pictured on the board if they have enough Euro. 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6	<p><b>Money - Was Kostet Das? - see below</b>            Revise counting/numbers by playing „Buzz Off“ in circle.            Read out German numbers from flashcards on board.            Have pictures of objects w/ prices attached in Euros.            Ask chn „Was Kostet Das?“ - see if they can work out what is being asked.            Encourage them to answer in German. Have chn go round circle asking neighbour „Was Kostet Das?“ &amp; pointing to an object. Beim Einkaufen</p> <p>Chn complete Cloze activity from 'Beim Einkaufen' - using list of vocab / replacing picture with correct word. Use Smartboard to complete together. Chn click &amp; drag correct item/uncover items after guessing.</p> <p>Play game p12-13 German Fun.</p> <p>Ich moechte... - ask for the things on the list. Partner gives the correct picture card.</p>		<p>Game - made from German Fun - enough for pairs (x15) - on card.</p> <p><b>Beim Einkaufen</b> - images scanned to smartboard file so chn can see text.</p> <p><b>Cloze activity</b> based on Beim Einkaufen</p> <p>Use images from the Bilderlexikon in the book.</p>	

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9	<p><b>Ich möchte....</b></p> <p>Put letters that spell "Ich möchte" into a small bag. Pass the bag round the circle, playing pass-parcel to a German song. If a child has the bag when music stops, they put letter in the middle. Give clue: 2 words.</p> <p>Play cumulative shopping game: Ich gehe einkaufen. Ich möchte... Go round circle, chn list all the previous items.</p> <p>Playing a shopping game - culmination of food, money, phrases.</p> <p>Play pair game: use Huckepack 11.13</p>		<p>small bag</p> <p>letters: "ich möchte"</p> <p>Huckepack 11.13 - modify for yr 2 game.</p> <p>List of items / vocab for chn to check.</p> <p>Assessment - on food / money / shopping</p>
