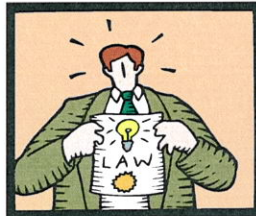


Design a poster listing all the things people mustn't do when visiting your bedroom

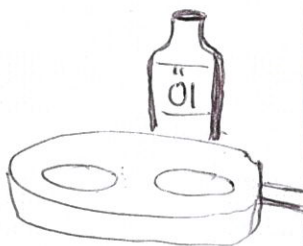
Using a *target language* homework help site (such as *devoirs.fr* for French), select a question for which you can provide some help and write your response to the student
