Students will interact with professionals in the theater in order to gain an understanding of the many skills and talents necessary for theater productions. Participate in scene studies and do a reading of student's written play. Students will attend five of the season's shows.

There is an additional cost of \$77.50 for this program.

All sessions take place on Wednesdays from 9:00 AM until 3:00 PM at the O'Reilly Theater. Curtain times are typically 11:30 a.m. or 12:00 Noon. Students will attend five shows. There will be two full day workshops on December 9 and February 17 and morning workshops on matinee days.
