

# MLA Citation Format

Use MLA format to cite your sources. A website that will do the formatting for you is [citationmachine.net](http://citationmachine.net). At this website, you will type in the information it asks and it will put it in correct MLA citation. Copy and paste it into your works cited page. Below is an example of what the works cited page should look like.

Remember:

- \*Hanging indent—this means that the author's names are hanging out on the first line.
- \*Put author's names or first word in the citation in alphabetical order.
- \*Put titles in italics.
- \*Put two spaces after each period.
- \*Citations are double-spaced.
- \*Title is Works Cited
- \*Use 12-point font
