

DESCRIPTION OF THE LEARNING CARPET, TLC

TLC is a permanently gridded, 100 square floor mat, (six feet square and bound on all sides), on which children from early years to grade 6 and special education, are better able to develop their understanding of mathematics and language through kinesthetic learning.

USING THE LEARNING CARPET

- supports early learners in acquiring, building on, and reinforcing math concepts and skills
- is appropriate for learners to use in developing and practising thinking and problem solving skills
- supports open-ended investigations that require early learners to use their reasoning and communication skills
- supports instruction, independent learning, and group work
- takes into account the needs and capabilities of early learners, e.g., physical, cognitive, developmental and real life experiences

LEARNERS WILL BE ABLE TO

- explain how they arrived at their answer and demonstrate their reasoning
- make sense of problems, reasoning abstractly, communicating and critiquing the reasoning of others
- solve problems, think conceptually, reason mathematically and demonstrate more skills than through rote memorization
