

Graphic Calculator: Window Settings

X-min = the # furthest to the LEFT on the window

X-max = the # furthest to the RIGHT on the window

X-scl = Increments your x-values increase by (2's, 10's)

Y-min = the # furthest to the BOTTOM on the window

Y-max = the # furthest to the TOP on the window

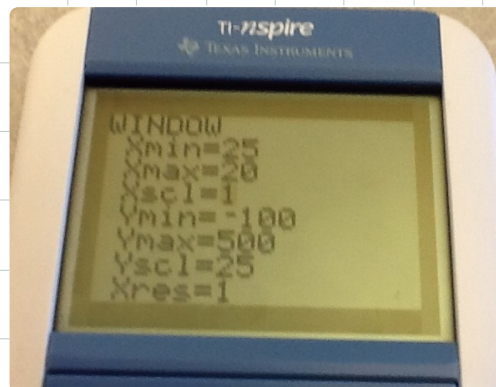
Y-scl = Increments your y-values increase by (1's, 200's)

Things to know:

1. The numbers you use for the x-values Do Not need to be the same for the y-values.

2. **Error: Window Range**

This means that you most likely put a bigger number for the x-min than for the x-max



3. **Error: Invalid Dim**

Make sure when you are looking at the "y =" window that none of the "plots" are turned on. If so, then turn off the plot.
