Location:

The Iguazu falls are in Argentina, specifically situated in the Iguazu National Park falls. Which is in La Patagonia, in the West- North part of the country, near to two countries: Paraguay and Brazil. The Iguazu Falls are in the Iguazu River, and are one of the world's largest waterfalls. They extend over 2,700 m (nearly 2 miles).The Iguazu waterfalls are composed by 275 falls, and the largest is called devil's Throat",which is at 80 meters of height.. Iguazu Falls are on the border between the Brazilian state of Paraná and the Argentine province of Misiones, which is in a tropical forest area, with a lot of rare and endangered species of flora and fauna.

The Iguazu Falls are one of the most visited place in

"Misiones", and one of the most imposing natural attractions in Argentina. And there are and important turistic area around the world. Is considered one of the great natural wonders of the world.

The name Iguazu simply means "great waters" in the local Indian language. According to legend, the great waterfall was created in an outburst of rage by the god of the Iguazu River, who lived in a particularly wild and violent area of the downpour called the Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat). The Falls are close to the point where the Iguazu and the Parana rivers join and the boundaries of Brazil, Argentina, and Paraguay converge. The countries are linked by two bridges: the Amistad (Friendship) Bridge between Brazil and Paraguay, and the Tancredo Neves Bridge between Brazil and Argentina.
