

Budget trip:

Budget of 400€.

Things I need:

- Transportation ticket.
- Youth hostels with its price.
- Places you will visit.
- Days you will spend.

Plannification of the trip:

First of all I would book a train ticket for a young person (less than 26 years old) in the interrail webpage for 169€. This ticket called Global Pass allows me to stay abroad 5 days in 10 days in one of the 30 countries available. I have chosen Switzerland as destination because I had already been in there when I was 10 and I got fascinated with its landscapes.

The ticket is also valid for other railway networks in the countries you visit, so you can save some money in that way and use one of the benefits you are given when you buy the Global Pass, which consists in 50% of discount in ferries and 10% of discount in hotels (the benefit varies depending on the country).

NOTE: There is another type of ticket called One Country Pass which allows you to travel from 3 to 8 days in one month, but my budget (231€ left) doesn't let me to stay that long.

Once in Switzerland I'd go to Zurich, where walking along the harbors near the Limmat and Sihl rivers is a recommended thing to do, and it's free. I want to visit the Schweizerisches Landesmuseum (10 CHF) and also go to Geneve. I would sleep one night at the Hotel Welcome Inn where rooms are available from 76€/night and then travel at the end of the next day sleeping in the train until I get to Geneve.

The first thing to do there is visit the Cathedrale St.Pierre (it's free) and its North Tower, which offers spectacular views (3 CHF). After that, I'd go to the Musée International de la Croix-Rouge (Red Cross museum) for 10 CHF, because I've been trained as a lifeguard by the Red Cross here in Sitges and I think the story of its foundation is very interesting. Besides, there is an exposition with pictures and other stories related to humanitarian aid and paramedics. On the last night of my trip I will sleep at the City Hostel Geneva for 61 CHF and leave the next day.
