Using the appropriate categories, complete the portfolio with ALL of your work to demonstrate what you have learned and validate the grade you believe is deserved.

Mapping an Empire – 2 map assignments

Getting to know the emperors – all work associated with (see PBS), include a reflection as to what you found out about yourself as a possible ruler from the quiz; handouts on Roman government

Religion in Politics and Daily Life – small group presentations on topics (include notes & research sources); mythology notes

Who's Who in Roman History – I have your poster for this assignment but you need to provide your notes and research; each person needs to provide information and responsibility in making their video

Slaves, the Labor Force, and the Economy - Compare the Roman social classes with the social classes that exist in America today. Create a pyramid or chart that compares the two sets of social classes and discusses the similarities and differences between them (this should be provided as a demonstration of your understanding)

The Violence of Ancient Rome – notes from video and class discussion; essay on chosen violence

Achievements – complete the web with the achievements of Roman culture and describe its impact upon future cultures

The Decline of Rome – lecture and video notes; editorial on reason for Roman decline

Reflection – include a paragraph of your thoughts for each topic discussed during our studies of Rome
