

# ALTERNATIVE ENERGIES LETTER

30 points

To review the advantages and disadvantages of fossil fuels, nuclear energy, and renewable energy sources, you are going to write a letter to your president, Barack Obama. The goal of your letter is to encourage him to support the use of more alternative energy sources in our country rather than just relying on fossil fuels. To show him your knowledge of energy sources, you should mention the specific advantages and disadvantages of each type of energy. However, to convince him to support you, show how the advantages of NOT using fossil fuels (but rather using nuclear or renewable energy) outweigh their disadvantages. You will be graded on the following criteria:

## Information (15 points)

- Explain at least 2 advantages of fossil fuels
- Explain at least 2 disadvantages of fossil fuels in general
- Explain at least 1 specific drawback to coal
- Explain at least 1 specific drawback to oil
- Explain at least 2 advantages of nuclear power
- Explain at least 2 disadvantages of nuclear power
- List at least 4 types of renewable energy sources
- Give at least 2 advantages of renewable energy
  - Explain which types you are referring to
- Give at least 2 disadvantages of renewable energy
  - Explain which types you are referring to

## Convincing Argument (5 points)

Now that you have given the facts, explain why you think OVERALL President Obama should consider promoting nuclear and renewable energy sources instead of relying primarily on fossil fuels. Write an introduction stating this purpose for writing the letter. Sum up your main points by writing a conclusion that includes the following:

- How do the advantages of nuclear and renewable energy sources outweigh their disadvantages?
- How do the disadvantages of fossil fuels outweigh their advantages?
- Why is this so important?

### Format (5 points)

- Follow the format on the attached page for composing a business letter
  - Heading
  - Inside Address
  - Salutation
  - Body
  - Closing
  - Signature
- Organize your information according to the paragraphs on the attached page
  - Substitute what is in italics with your own information
- Neatness counts! You may type it or write it by hand (using blue or black ink). Either way, do not cross things out on your good copy, but rewrite/retype it as needed.

### Spelling and Grammar (5 points)

- Spelling and grammar do count, so proofread your letter.
- Check your spelling.
- Be sure to use complete sentences (subject, verb).
- Remember to use correct capitalization and punctuation.
- Use formal language to communicate respectfully.

*4<sup>th</sup> paragraph: Summarize your main points. Convince President Obama to promote alternatives to fossil fuels by explaining why nuclear and energy sources have more advantages. You could also discuss the importance of energy conservation and developing technologies to reduce pollution. Be polite, and thank him for his time.*
