

“Animoto” Pollution Video

30 pts

You will be working with a partner to create 2 videos of scrolling text and pictures to illustrate sources, types, impacts, and treatment of water and air pollution. Use your notes from the water pollution and air pollution units to get ideas for each category.

What to Include

- Water Pollution Video
 - For EACH of the following, you need AT LEAST **TWO** pictures **AND** AT LEAST **ONE** text explaining those pictures
 - Sources of water pollution
 - Types of water pollution
 - Impacts of water pollution
 - Treatment/prevention of water pollution
- Air Pollution Video
 - For EACH of the following, you need AT LEAST **TWO** pictures **AND** AT LEAST **ONE** text explaining those pictures
 - Sources of air pollution
 - Types of air pollution
 - Impacts of air pollution
 - Treatment/prevention of air pollution

Collecting your Images

- Go to google.com and click on Images (at top)
- Search for appropriate pictures that tie in to the categories above
 - **Use your notes for more specific ideas regarding each topic**
- When you find a picture you like
 - Click on it
 - When you see the larger image, right click and choose “Save picture as”
 - Save it to your network drive and rename it to describe the picture

Logging in to Animoto

- Go to Animoto.com
- Click “Sign in” (upper right)
 - Email address: fortcherry.amos+##@gmail.com
 - **Note: You will substitute the “#” with the following number assigned to your group _____**
 - Password: environment
- Note: You can both be logged in to the same account as long as you are working on two separate videos

Creating Your Animoto Video

- Click “Create video” (upper right)
- Choose a style
 - You can preview the styles
 - When you find one you like, click “create”
- Click “Advanced Settings” (upper right-hand corner)
 - Video Title
 - Your names and Water or Air Pollution Video
 - Ex: “John Doe and Jane Doe’s Water Pollution Video”
 - Producer
 - Change this to your names
 - Description
 - “Water Pollution Video” or “Air Pollution Video”
 - Video length
 - Choose “Full length”
 - Image pacing
 - Choose “Automatic”
 - Click “Save”
- Add Pics and Videos
 - Find the option “From Your Computer,” and click “Upload” to access the pictures you saved using google images
 - You can select many pictures at one time by holding the shift or control key
 - You may also select images from animoto’s collection, but you are NOT to include videos (they use up too much time and do not relate)
- Choose Music
 - You MUST choose from the music on the site
 - Do NOT spend forever on this...it will not get you more points!
- Add Text
 - Create a title slide for each video (ie: Water Pollution or Air Pollution)
 - Insert text explaining each of your images
 - Note: This can be divided as a Header and Subtext
 - Header: Category (ie: Sources, Types, Impacts, or Treatment)
 - Subtext: Specifically describes what the following pictures have to do with that category
 - **Be sure to put the text BEFORE the image you want it to describe**

- Other
 - You can drag text and images if you want to change the order
 - Note: Shuffle will mix them all up
 - If you click on an image and then select “Spotlight,” that image will be spotlighted in the final video
 - You can delete pictures or text by selecting its box and then clicking on the trash can icon
- Be sure to SAVE as you go
- You can edit your video later by clicking on “Continue” or using the “Edit Project” pull down menu next to your video and selecting “Edit/Create New Video”
- When you are **COMPLETELY FINISHED** , click “Produce Video” (this takes a little while, so leave yourself some time for this step)

You will be graded on the following criteria:

1. Information (24 points)
 - Do you have at least 2 pictures AND at least 1 text explaining EACH of the following categories for BOTH Water and Air Pollution?
 - Sources
 - Types
 - Impacts
 - Treatment/Prevention
2. Format (6 points)
 - Did you name your videos as directed?
 - Did you choose music for your videos?
 - Did you create a title slide for each video?
 - Are the pictures appropriate for each category?
 - Does the text make sense in terms of format and spelling?
 - Do your videos flow well, making them easy to follow and understand?
